AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO CONTROL AND PROHIBIT THE LITTERING OF THE CITY'S PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAMPTON, GEORGIA, AND IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY AUTHORITY THEREOF, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.

- (a) The word "Litter" means all sand, gravel, slag, brickbats, rubbish, waste material, tincans, refuse, garbage, trash, paper, dead animals or discarded materials of any kind and description.
- (b) The phrase "Public or Private Property" means the right-of-way of any road, alley, street or highway, any body of water or water course thereof; any park, playground or recreation area, any residential or farm properties, timberlands or forest.

SECTION 2: UNLAWFUL ACTIVITIES.

It shall be unlawful for any person to dump, deposit, throw or leave litter on any public or private property in this city.

SECTION 3: PENALTIES.

Any person violating the provisions of section 2 shall be punished by a fine of \$25.00, or, in lieu thereof may be directed by the Judge to pick up and remove such litter.

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
