

AMENDMENT TO BEER AND WINE ORDINANCE  
ORDINANCE NO. 34-1C  
CITY OF HAMPTON, GEORGIA

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 34-1A of the City of Hampton (governing the issuance and revocation of retail licenses for the sale of malt beverages and wine), prohibiting the maintenance of electronic games on the licensed premises.

WHEREAS, on April 12, 1988, the City of Hampton adopted Ordinance No. 34-1A, governing the issuance and revocation of retail licenses for the sale of malt beverages and wine and related matters; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of Hampton deem it to be in the public interest to prevent children from loitering on the premises where beer and wine is sold by prohibiting the operation of electronic games, pinball machines, pool tables and crane games on the premises;

NOW, THEREFORE, by and through the authority of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Hampton, it is hereby ordained as follows:

SECTION ONE

Article V of Ordinance No. 34-1A of the City of Hampton, adopted April 12, 1988, is hereby amended by striking same in its entirety and replacing it with a new Article V to read as follows:

No license shall be issued or renewed after the effective date of this Ordinance 34-1C for any premises upon which any video game or other electronic game, pool table, pinball machine, or crane game is operated.

SECTION TWO

Except as expressly modified, amended or repealed hereby, said

Ordinance of April 12, 1988, known as Ordinance No. 34-1A, City of Hampton, shall remain in full force and effect. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the Mayor and Council.


