

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE
NO. 48 OF THE CITY OF HAMPTON, GEORGIA;
TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO FIX
AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

ORDINANCE NO. 48A

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAMPTON, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE AUTHORITY THEREOF, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 48 of the City of Hampton, Georgia, adopted on July 10, 1984, is hereby amended by deleting Paragraph (A) of Section 1 of said Ordinance in its entirety and by replacing it with a new Paragraph (A) which shall read as follows:

A. The City may issue a Fi. Fa. upon the property upon which the services were provided and proceed with levy and sale of said property as authorized by law provided that no lien shall be imposed against real property to secure unpaid charges for electrical, water or sewerage services unless the owner of such real property is the person who incurred the charges, to the extent that such a lien is prohibited by O.C.G.A. §36-60-17 or any other provision of state law; or

Section 2. Except as expressly amended hereby, Ordinance No. 48 of the City of Hampton shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.




