ORDINANCE NUMBER 1, SECTION 40

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CITY ORDINANCE NUMBER 1, BY ADDING SECTION 40; TO PROHIBIT GIVING FALSE INFORMATION TO A POLICE OFFICER; TO PROVIDE FOR ENFORCEMENT; TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton, Georgia, in the exercise of their sound judgment and discretion, after giving thorough thought to all the implications involved, and keeping in mind the public interest and welfare of the citizens of the City of Hampton, have determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Hampton that Ordinance Number 1 be amended by adding Section 40.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAMPTON, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY AUTHORITY THEREOF, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 40:

A person who gives a false name, address, or date of birth to a law enforcement officer in the lawful discharge of his official duties with the intent of misleading the officer as to his identity or birthdate is guilty of a misdemeanor. Any person violating this section of this Ordinance, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than \$100.00 and not to exceed the amount authorized under the Charter of this City, or imprisonment not to exceed 6 months, or both.

BE IT ORDAINED, that any ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby specifically repealed.

BE IT ORDAINED, that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are severable; and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, that unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the Mayor and Council without the incorporation in this Ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.
