

ORDINANCE NO. 80  
TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 21B TO  
ADD SECTION 11 IN ORDER  
TO PROVIDE FOR THE COLLECTION OF  
LICENSE FEES ON ALL INSURERS

To amend the City's Ordinance No. 21B to impose license fees on insurers conducting business within the City of Hampton; to provide an effective date for the amendment; to repeal directly conflicting ordinances; and for other purposes.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton, and it is hereby ordained by authority thereof:

Ordinance No. 21B is hereby amended by adding the following:

Section 11. Insurer License Fees - All Insurers Doing Business in the City of Hampton

A) There is hereby levied for the year 1993 and for each year thereafter an annual license fee upon each insurer doing business within the City of Hampton in the amount of Forty Dollars (\$40.00). For each separate business location in excess of one which is operating on behalf of such insurers within the City of Hampton, there is hereby levied a license fee in the amount of Forty Dollars (\$40.00). For the purposes of this ordinance, the term "insurer" means a company which is authorized to transact business in any of the classes of insurance designated in O.C.G.A. Section 33-3-5.

B) Administrative Provisions. The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a duly certified copy of this ordinance to the

Insurance Commissioner of the State of Georgia within 45 days of its enactment.

C) Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective as of January 1, 1993.

D) Severability. In the event any portion of this ordinance shall be declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Hampton that such adjudication shall in no manner affect the other sections, sentences, clauses or phrases of this ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect, as if the invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause or phrase were not originally a part of the ordinance.

E) Repealer. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in direct conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. However, all portions of any ordinance not in direct conflict herewith, including but not limited to those imposing insurance agency license fees, and gross premium taxes on life insurers and other types of insurers remain in full force and effect and are unchanged by this amendment.


