

ORDINANCE NO. 81

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF HAMPTON TO PROVIDE FOR
ADMINISTRATION OF CERTAIN STATE OFFENSES IN
MUNICIPAL COURTS; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING
ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF HAMPTON, GEORGIA, and by the authority thereof:

Section 1. The City hereby elects to exercise jurisdiction
over all those State offenses for which a grant of jurisdiction has
been provided by general State Law. In the exercise of that
jurisdiction, officers writing tickets returnable to the Municipal
Court, shall delineate the nature of the offense charged by name
and Georgia Code Number on the citation and summons. Offenses to
be cited and brought before the Municipal Court for final
adjudication include:

(1) Possession of one (1) ounce or less of marijuana,
pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 16-13-30 and §16-13-2;

(2) Operating a motor vehicle without effective insurance,
pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 40-6-10;

(3) Theft by shoplifting when the property which is the
subject of this theft is valued at one hundred (\$100.00) dollars or
less, pursuant to O.C.G.A. §16-8-14;

(4) Furnishing alcoholic beverages to and possession and
purchase of alcoholic beverages by persons under 21 years of age,
pursuant to O.C.G.A. §3-3-23 and §3-3-23.1; and

(5) Criminal trespass, pursuant to O.C.G.A. §16-7-21.


Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.


