

ORDINANCE NO. 95

TO ADOPT THE HENRY COUNTY FIRE PREVENTION CODE;
TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO
PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of
the City of Hampton, Georgia, and by the authority thereof:

Section 1. Fire Prevention Code Adopted.

That the Fire Prevention Code of Henry County, Georgia,
Ordinance No. 92-10, adopted by the Henry County Board of
Commissioners on December 1, 1992, which has been
codified in Chapter 3-4, Section 3-4-131 of the Henry
County Code of Ordinances, is hereby incorporated by
reference herein and made the Fire Prevention Code of the
City of Hampton, Georgia.

Copies of the 1991 Edition of the Standard Fire Prevention
Code, including all appendices and amendments thereto shall be
maintained on file in the Office of the City Clerk where they shall
be available for public inspection.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances
previously adopted or in conflict with this ordinance are, to the
extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.


Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective
