


AN ORDINANCE AS TO ANIMAL, AMENDED March 4 1975

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to have, possess or control any chickens, ducks, geese, turkeys, other fowls, pigs or hogs within the City limits of the City of Hampton except by written permit, recommended by the Sanitation Committee of said City of Hampton and approved by the Mayor. The Sanitation Committee will furnish all applicants for permits a set of regulations that will cover each individual condition. Pens and yards and other places where such fowl and such pigs or hogs are kept shall be maintained in a clean and sanitary condition and shall be subject to inspection at all times by the sanitation committee of said City of Hampton and permits may be cancelled upon failure of the owner or owners to comply with the Sanitation Committees recommendations. Any person, firm or corporation violating this ordinance may be fined Two Hundred Dollars or required to work on the streets of said City not more than 30 days or confined for not longer thirty days.

Adopted as amended at a regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council on 4 March 1975.
