

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE HENRY COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hampton, Georgia, in order to guide and accomplish a coordinated and harmonious development of the municipality and county which will, in accordance with existing and future needs, best promote public health, safety, morals, order, convenience, prosperity, and the general welfare, as well as efficiency and economy in the process of development, that the Henry County Planning Commission, hereinafter referred to as the Planning Commission, is hereby created and established as authorized by the General Planning and Zoning Enabling Act of 1957(Act No.358) and said Planning Commission shall be organized and empowered as follows:

Section 1. Membership. The Henry County Planning Commission shall consist of six members. The members shall be appointed as follows: The Board of Commissioners shall appoint one member to serve three years, one member to serve four years, and one member to serve five years; McDonough shall appoint one member to serve three years; Hampton shall appoint one member to serve four years; and Stockbridge shall appoint one member to serve five years. After expiration of the initial term, appointments of their successors shall all be for a term of three years. Any vacancy in membership shall be filled for the unexpired term by the appointing authority which shall also have the authority to remove their appointee for cause, on written charges, after a public hearing. All members shall serve without but may be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred in connection with their official duties.

Fayette, Georgia, in order to guide and accomplish a co-

economy in the process of development, that the Henry County
Planning Commission, hereinafter referred to as the Planning
Commission, is hereby created and established as authorized by
the General Planning and Zoning Enabling Act of 1957 (Act No. 337)
and said Planning Commission shall be organized and empowered
as follows:

Section 1. Membership. The Henry County Planning Commission
shall consist of six members. The members shall be appointed as
follows: The board of Commissioners shall appoint one member to
serve three years, one member to serve four years, and one mem-
ber to serve five years; McDonough shall appoint one member to
serve three years; Fayette shall appoint one member to serve
four years; and Stockbridge shall appoint one member to serve
five years. After expiration of the initial term, appointments
of their successors shall all be for a term of three years. Any
vacancy in membership shall be filled for the unexpired term by
the appointing authority which shall also have the authority to
remove their appointee for cause, on written charges, after a
public hearing. All members shall serve without pay but may be reim-
bursed for actual expenses incurred in connection with their
official duties.

Section 2. Organization, Rules, Staff, and Finances. The Henry County Planning Commission shall elect its chairman from among its members. The term of the chairman shall be one year with eligibility for re-election. The Commission shall appoint a secretary who may be an officer or employee of one of the municipalities or the county. The Planning Commission shall make its own rules of rules of procedure and determine its time of meeting. All meetings of the Planning Commission at which official action is taken is to be open to the public and all records of the Planning Commission shall be a public record. The Planning Commission may appoint such employees and staff as it may deem necessary for its work and may contract with the State Planning Commission and with City planners and other consultants for such services as it may require. The expenditures of the Planning Commission, exclusive of gifts, shall be within the amounts appropriated for the purpose by the governing authorities of the municipalities and the county.

Section 3. Powers and Duties. From and after the time when the planning commission shall have organized and selected its officers, and shall have adopted its rules of procedure, then said Planning Commission shall have all the powers, duties and responsibilities set forth in the General Planning and Zoning Enabling Act of 1957. (Act. No. 358)

Section 4. Be it further ordained, that all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Be it further ordained, That this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare of the City of Hampton, Georgia, requiring it.

Section 2. Organization, Rules, Staff, and Finance. The

Henry County Planning Commission shall elect its chairman from among its members. The term of the chairman shall be one year with eligibility for re-election. The Commission shall appoint a secretary who may be an officer or employee of one of the municipalities in the county. The Planning Commission shall make its own rules of rules of procedure and determine its time of meeting. All meetings of the Planning Commission at which official action is taken is to be open to the public and all records of the Planning Commission shall be a public record. The Planning Commission may appoint such employees and staff as it may deem necessary for its work and may contract with the Planning Commission and with City planners and other consultants for such services as it may require. The expenditures of the Planning Commission, exclusive of gifts, shall be within the amounts appropriated for the purpose by the governing authorities of the municipalities and the county.

Section 3. Powers and Duties. From and after the time when

the planning commission shall have organized and selected its officers, and shall have adopted its rules of procedure, then said Planning Commission shall have all the powers, duties and responsibilities set forth in the General Planning and Zoning Ordinance of 1957. (Ord. No. 388)

Section 4. Be it further ordained, that all ordinances in

conflict herewith are hereby repealed. Be it further ordained, That this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare of the City of Hatcher, Georgia, requiring it.
